PROJECT ALPHA Leadership Club



Omicron Rho Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. would like to inform you we are accepting applications for young males to be members of our leadership program. We're focusing on 12 to 17 year-old boys and this program helps young boys focus on being the best they could be. Brothers offer themselves as Role Models to "At-Risk" groups. They provide one-on-one mentoring as well as workshops on family values, self-esteem, sexual behavior, life after school, leadership skills and scholarship/academic achievement.

The program is a two-part program. One part is the Leadership Development Institute sponsored by the Omicron Rho Lambda Chapter for the same age group of young men, which prepare outstanding junior and high school students in the vital skills of leadership. The other part is Project Alpha, a national program, designed to help young men make better and more informed choices about their sexual behavior. Since 1980, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. and the March of Dimes have been working together to help



young men make the right decisions about the complex issues surrounding sex. This is a unique mentoring program, which offers African-American men as positive role models for the next generation. This program was developed to increase the knowledge of the African-American male of the consequences of teenage pregnancy from the male perspective. This program seeks to assist young men in developing and understanding their role in preventing untimely pregnancies through responsible attitudes and behaviors and it attempts to reach younger adolescents before they have established risk-taking behavior that may be difficult to reverse.

Project Alpha Leadership Club usually meets once a month on Saturdays for 1 ½ - 2 hours during the school year and has volunteer guest speakers with backgrounds in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math (STEM), Education, Medical, Legal, Political, etc. The members participate in different leadership exercises. This program is very beneficial to the young men in the Vicksburg community. This is definitely a program that we feel would make a difference within our community.



EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS & SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Omicron Rho Lambda Book Scholarship

Applicant must be a member of PALC and a graduating senior who have attended at least 60% of the leadership club's meetings and events his senior year and received a letter of acceptance of enrollment to a college or university.
